## Reflecting the Principle through Self Evaluation Life Principle #10

If necessary, God will move heaven and earth to show us His will.

- How can you know for sure that you've heard Him correctly? *Ask yourself these questions:* 
  - Is it consistent with the Word of God?
  - Is it a wise decision?
  - Can I honestly ask the Lord to help me achieve this?
  - Do I have genuine peace about it?
  - Does this decision fit who I am as a follower of Jesus? Does it fit the Lord's overall plan for my life?
  - Will this decision honor God?

## How can you discover God's plan for you?

- The Bible: Apply scriptural truth so you won't drift away from God's will (Ps. 119:105).
- **Prayer:** The Lord promises to guide us when we pray according to His will (1 John 5:14-15).
- Circumstances: For a child of God, there is no such thing as coincidence. .
- Godly counsel: Before taking advice, make sure the person counseling you leads a righteous life. Ask, "What do you think the Word of God says I should do?"
- Your conscience: It is the moral filter of your life. Develop a godly conscience by saturating
  your mind with the Word of God, and your decisions will become more Christ-like over time.
- Restless spirit: Dr. Stanley has always felt restless before major life changes. When this happens, it's wise to ask God, "What are You saying to me?"

## What are some hindrances to discovering God's will?

- Self-will: If you have already made up your mind, it will be difficult to hear what the Lord wants you to do.
- The influence of others: Others may comment that God wouldn't expect you to make such a large sacrifice—and thereby discourage you from obeying.
- Ignorance of God's Word
- Unworthiness
