- Is there are area of your life that you have not brought into submission to God's will?
- What part of your attitude has the Lord convicted you about lately self-righteousness, self-reliance, self-centeredness?
- Are you allowing any of the following to get in the way of the Lord teaching you to rely more on Him? pride, ignorance, fear, worldly entanglements, unhealthy relationships, rebelliousness, strongholds of Satan Ask the Lord to reveal to you how you are blocking Him using you to the fullest.
